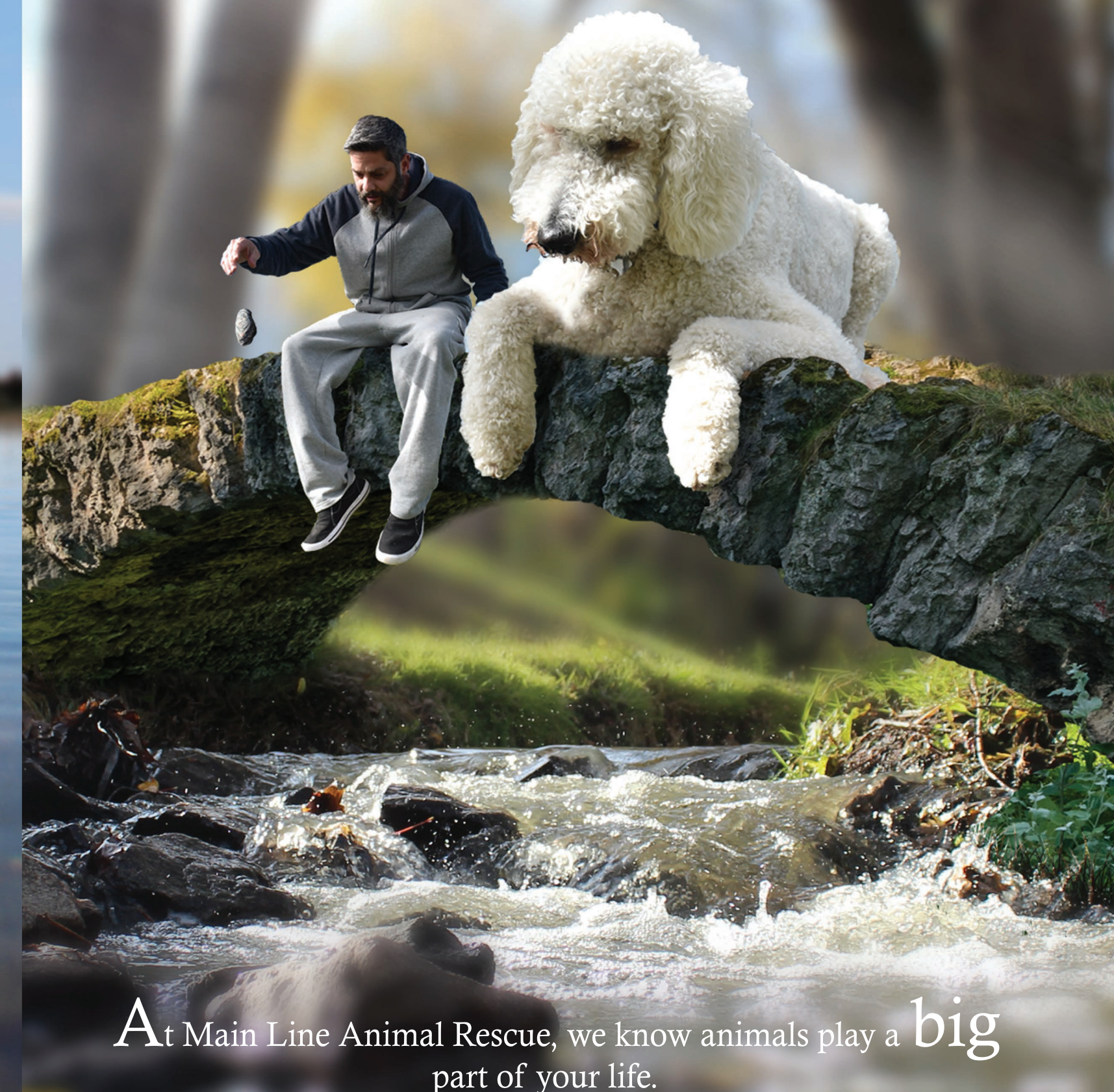
When others would rather not rock the boat, MLAR speaks out in a **big way**.
